

Messy Mornings: Frequently Asked Questions

Is my baby too young to go to Messy Mornings?

Babies of all ages are welcome to attend Messy Mornings. The activities are designed to enrich children's creativity and awareness of the visual world around them while also helping to develop fine motor skills. Even the smallest babies will enjoy the songs and getting their hands messy with paint.

Are the materials safe for small children?

All of the paints and materials used in Messy Mornings are safe and non-toxic. We do require that the accompanying adult supervises their child at all times and works with them on their art project. Some use of scissors and other materials may be required to complete art projects, which we ask the accompanying adult to carry out.

I have a 3year-old and an 18month old. Which would be the best session for them both to attend?

You are welcome to attend either session with both of your children. Come along to whichever one works best time-wise for you.

Can my partner and I bring our child together? How much would this cost?

Two adults are welcome to bring one child to Messy Mornings together. This would be the standard cost of admission for one child.

Is food available at the Rockhampton Museum of Art?

Food and drink is not allowed into Gallery spaces of Rockhampton Museum of Art, Hummingbird Art Gallery Café is accessible from the colonnade/Customs House side of the building. Opening hours for the café are listed on our website.
